So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free. John 8:31-32 So now we have a famous former athlete, at one time the image of ideal physical manhood, who "identifies" as a woman, and an activist woman of impeccably white pedigree who "identifies" as a black woman. And perhaps as never before have evangelical Christians enjoyed such an advantage over the rest of society.

In case you haven't noticed, this world, in which believers must temporarily dwell, is currently wallowing in the septic bilge of postmodernism, political correctness, perceived reality, "microaggressions" and "trigger warnings," and other insanities. This bilious, quicksand culture has painted us into a verbal corner: Think the wrong thought and you might lose your teaching position; say just about anything and you could be fired.
