FOREWORD

This booklet has been created as a companion to our Last Things study notes. In fact, the charts contained herein represent the initial impetus behind the study itself. The goal of the study from its inception was to produce a handy reference for those times one cannot quite recall the sequence of events in the Eschaton (literally, “last things”). End time prophecies can be confusing and easily mislaid in one’s memory. This booklet serves as a handy (digital) reference for those times.

There are myriad interpretations of the Eschaton; this study is unapologetically based on a *pretribulational* (or *dispensational*), *premillennial* interpretation of God’s word regarding the end times. See the accompanying session notes for more details.

During the initial teaching of this study in our local church, along with the distribution of these charts there were occasional informational handouts distributed. These handouts have been included with their respective sessions in the study notes file. *This* file is intended to be used alongside the study notes file. If you are using the latter for a systematic study of the Last Things, you should keep this file and its charts handy for those times when they are referenced in the text.

Feel free to print the pages in this booklet for your personal or classroom use, but keep in mind that some charts include illustrations that are best viewed on-screen, where one can zoom into the hi-res images to see all the details. THE TRIBULATION

The Fifth Trumpet

Revelation 9:1-11



Then the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star from heaven which had fallen to the earth; and the key of the bottomless pit was given to him. He opened the bottomless pit, and smoke went up out of the pit, like the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by the smoke of the pit.

Then out of the smoke came locusts upon the earth, and power was given them, as the scorpions of the earth have power. They were told not to hurt the grass of the earth, nor any green thing, nor any tree, but only the men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads. And they were not permitted to kill anyone, but to torment for five months; and their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it stings a man.

And in those days men will seek death and will not find it; they will long to die, and death flees from them. The appearance of the locusts was like horses prepared for battle; and on their heads appeared to be crowns like gold, and their faces were like the faces of men. They had hair like the hair of women, and their teeth were like the teeth of lions. They had breastplates like breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings was like the sound of chariots, of many horses rushing to battle. They have tails like scorpions, and stings; and in their tails is their power to hurt men for five months.

They have as king over them, the angel of the abyss; his name in Hebrew is Abaddon, and in the Greek he has the name Apollyon.

The Sixth Trumpet

Revelation 9:13-21



Then the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, one saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates." And the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released, so that they would kill a third of mankind.

The number of the armies of the horsemen was two hundred million; I heard the number of them. And this is how I saw in the vision the horses and those who sat on them: the riders had breastplates the color of fire and of hyacinth and of brimstone; and the heads of the horses are like the heads of lions; and out of their mouths proceed fire and smoke and brimstone. A third of mankind was killed by these three plagues, by the fire and the smoke and the brimstone which proceeded out of their mouths. For the power of the horses is in their mouths and in their tails; for their tails are like serpents and have heads, and with them they do harm.

The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, so as not to worship demons, and the idols of gold and of silver and of brass and of stone and of wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk; and they did not repent of their murders nor of their sorceries nor of their immorality nor of their thefts.

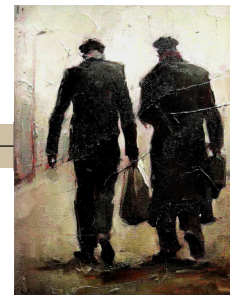

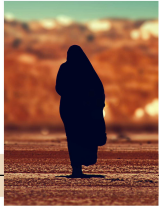
The twenty-four elders offer praise and thanksgiving to God. The heavenly temple (sanctuary) opened.

12:1-6



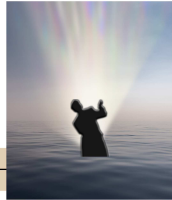
War in heaven. Michael fights with the dragon (Satan). The dragon is defeated and is thrown down to earth.

The Lamb on Mt. Zion with 144,000, having His name and the name of His Father on their foreheads.



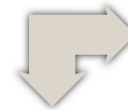
14:1-5
